- Entrepreneur:** Start a business of your choice with all the financial skills needed to adequately manage the finances.
- Consultant:** Assisting other business with strategic/specialist business advice.
- Education:** teaching and training of others on financial matters.

Then you can be a part of the School of Accounting & Comm (Acc) with the eventual goal of becoming a chartered accountant!

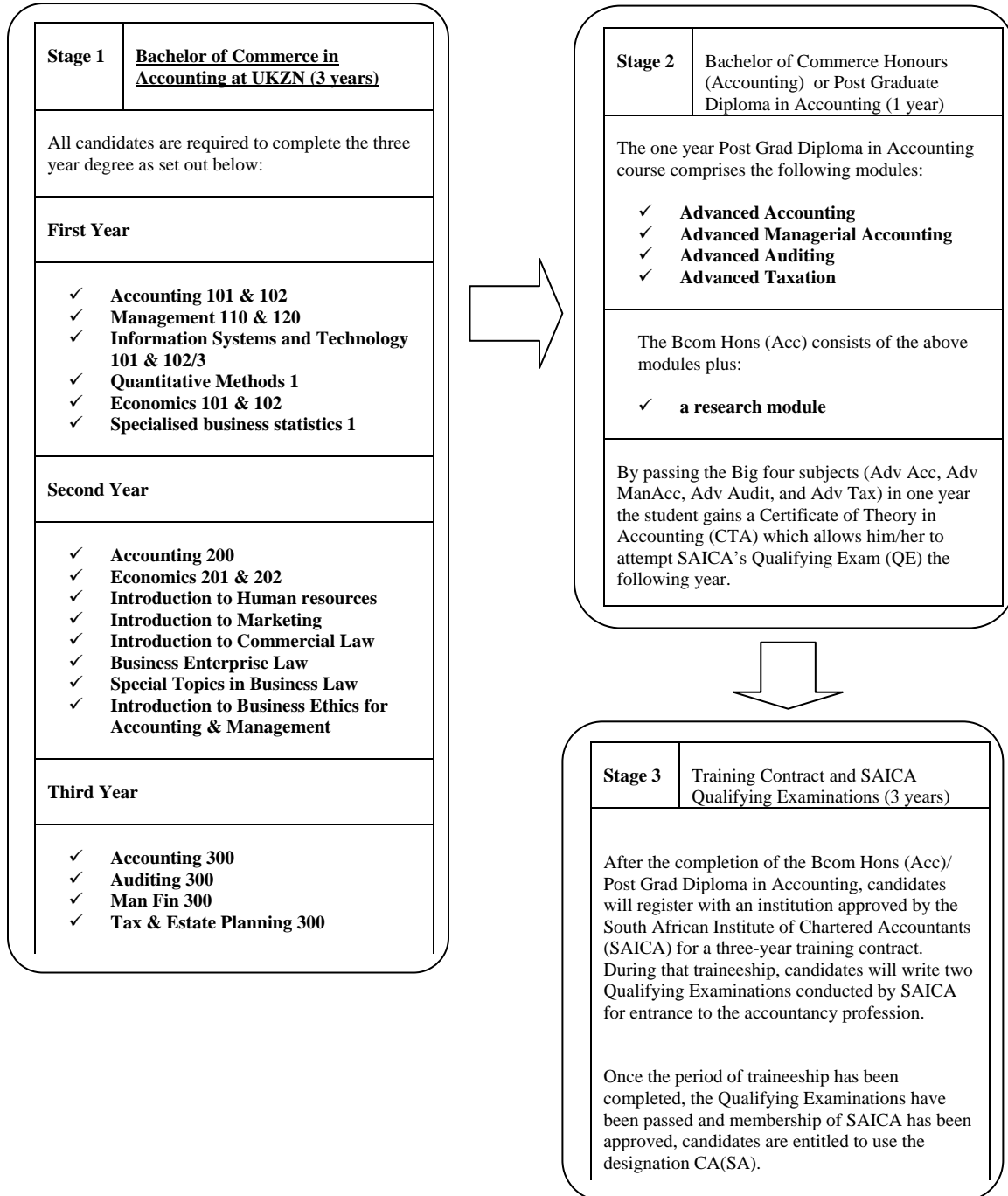
The University of KwaZulu-Natal is accredited by the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA).
